OF 40 YEARS

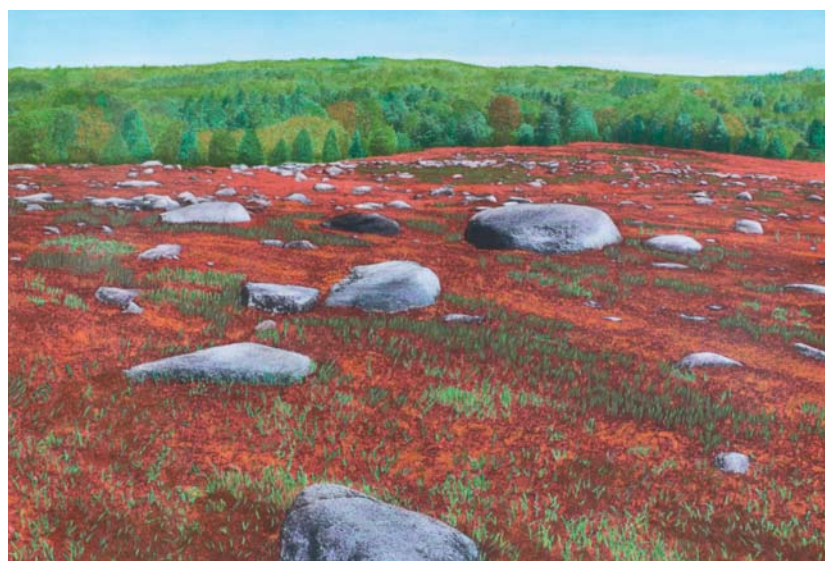

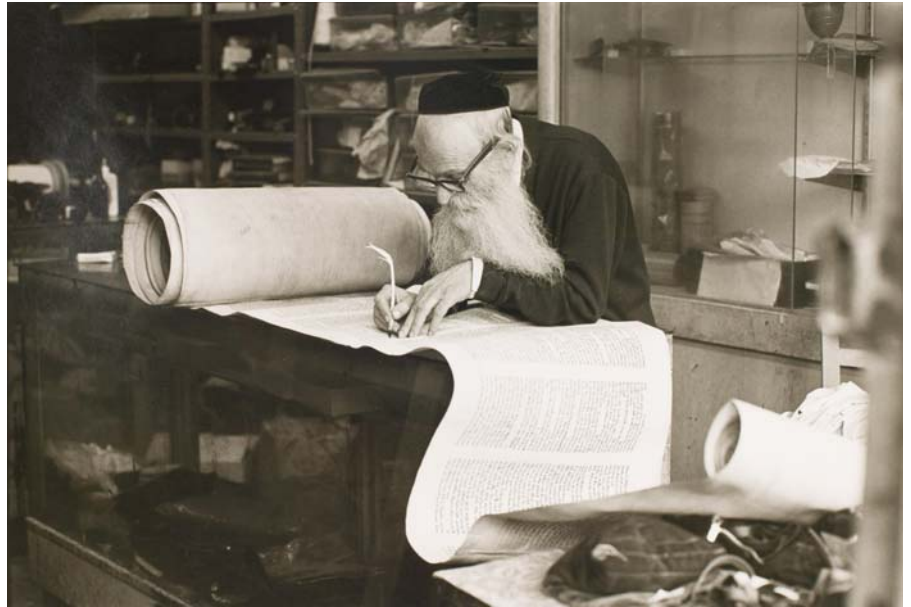

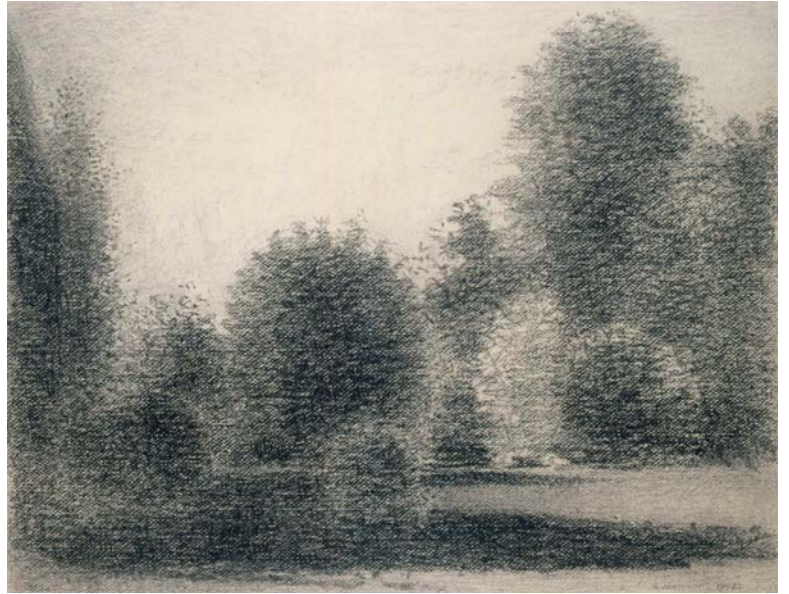

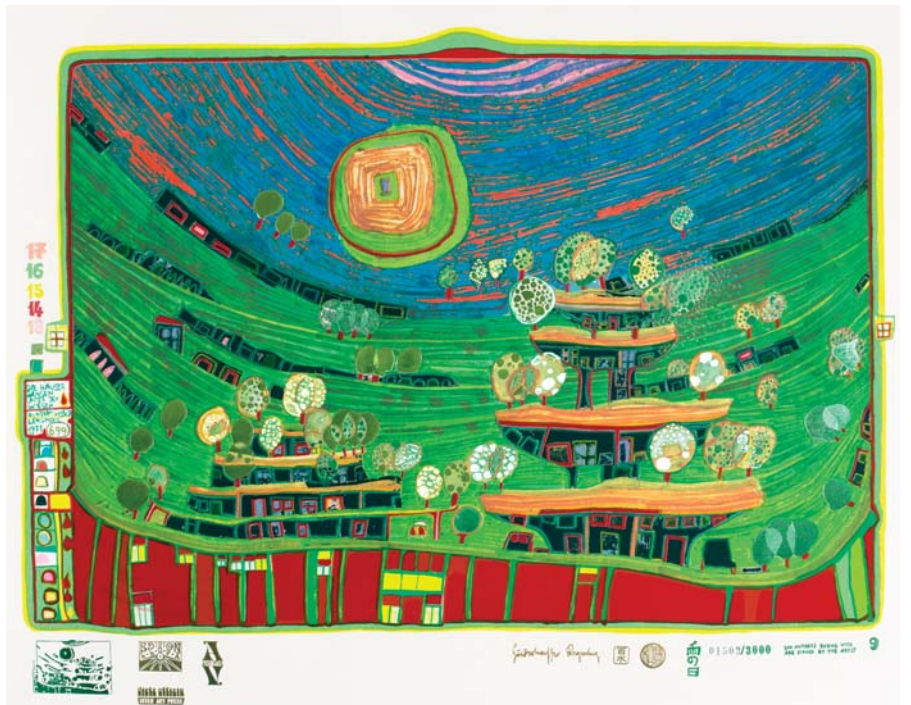

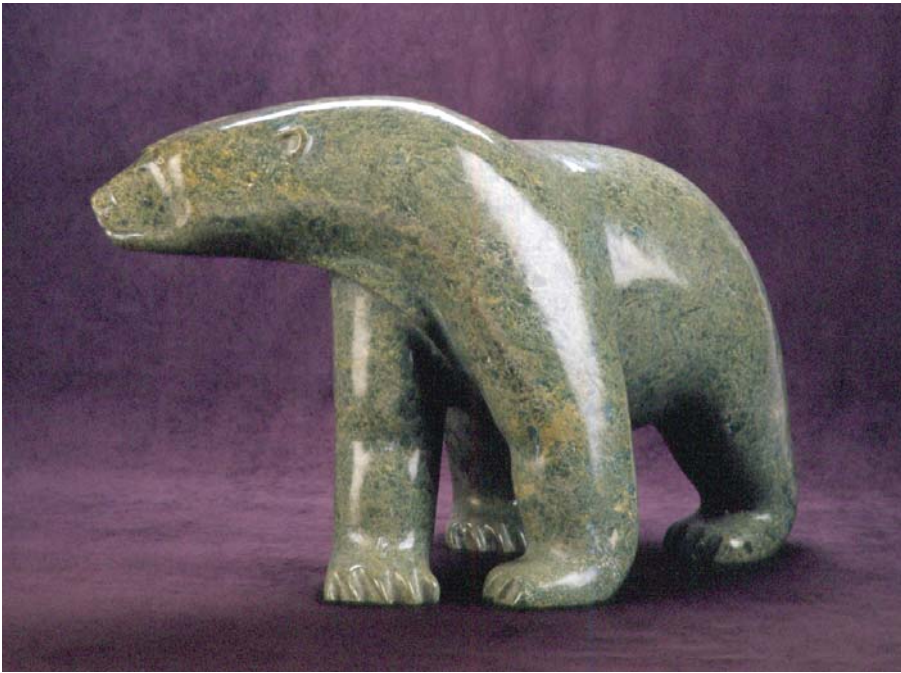

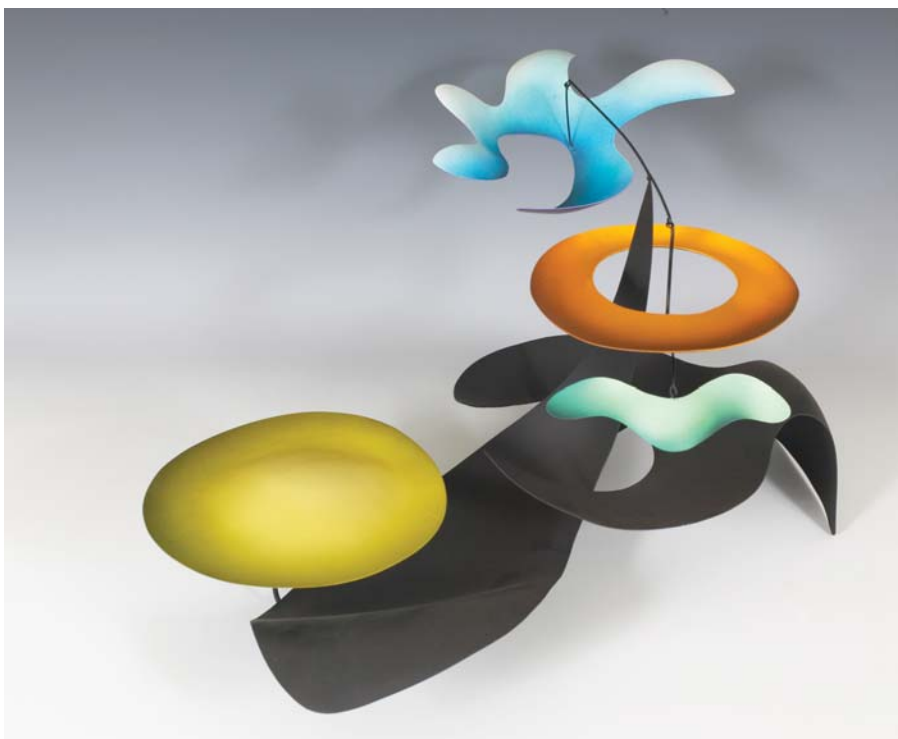

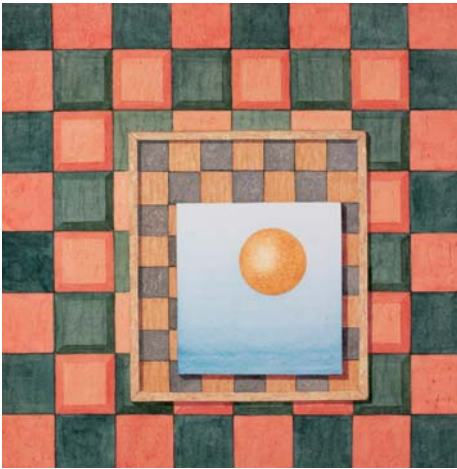

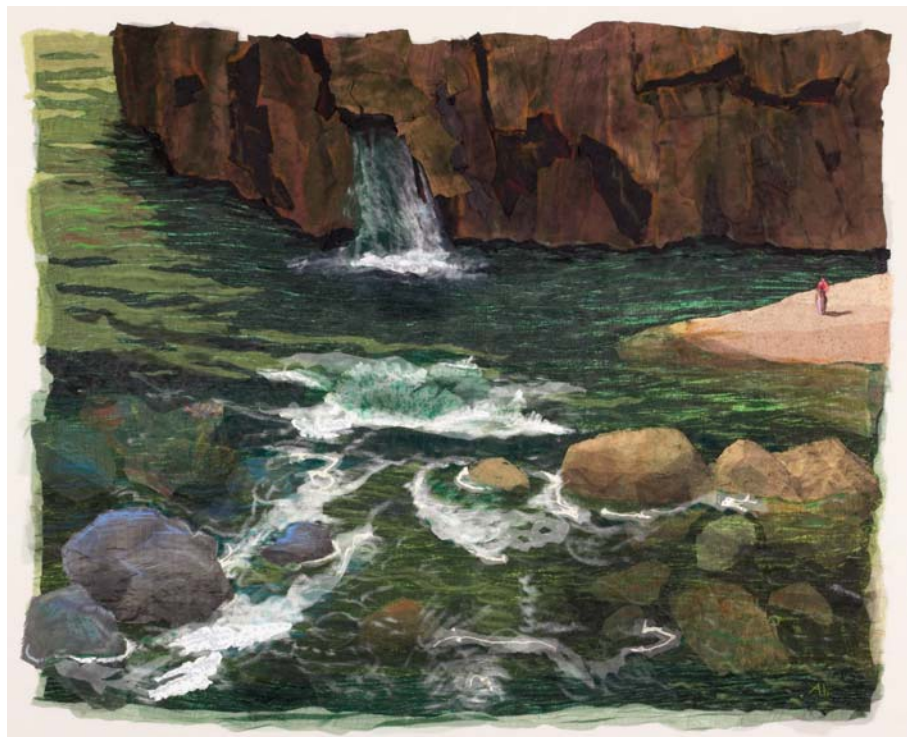

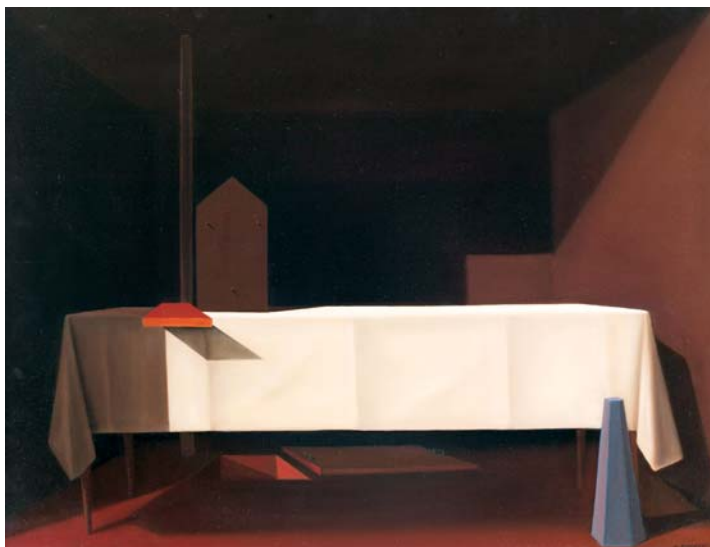

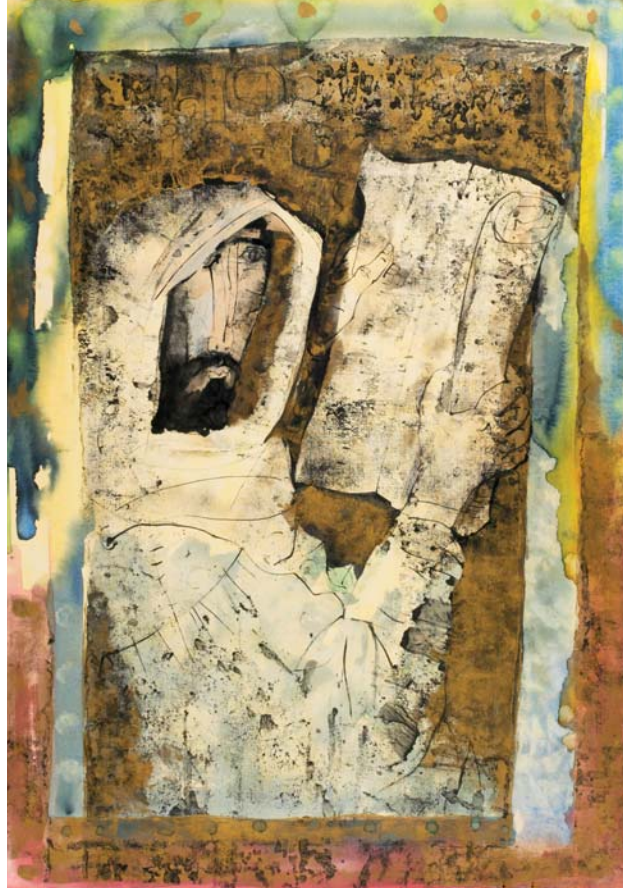

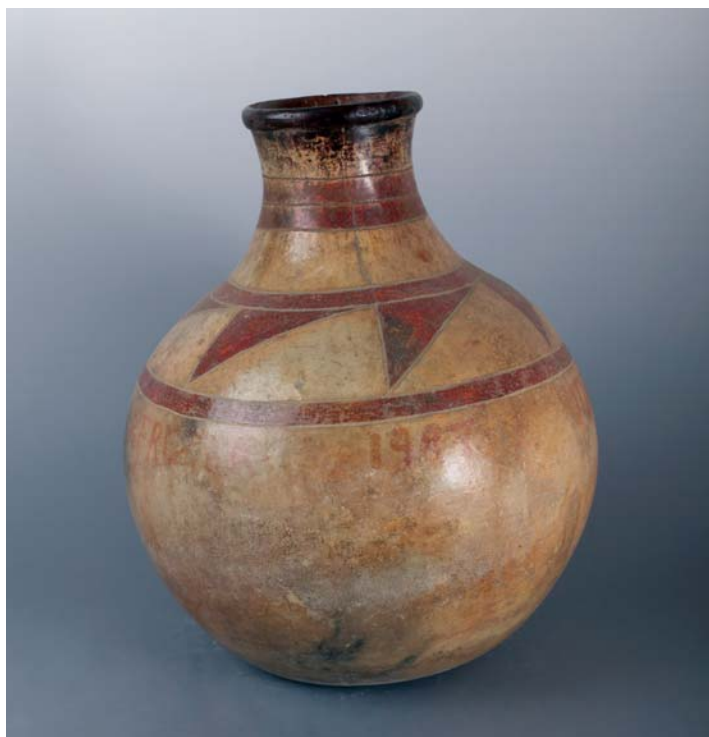
